



PROPER AFTERCARE IS ESSENTIAL TO MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY, APPEARANCE, AND LONGEVITY OF YOUR DREAD EXTENSIONS. PLEASE REVIEW AND ACKNOWLEDGE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR DREADS:

Showering:

- Wait at least 7 days after installation before washing your hair.
- Use a sulfate-free, residue-free shampoo.
- Gently cleanse the scalp, focusing on your roots. Avoid aggressive scrubbing of the dread extensions.
- Rinse thoroughly to avoid product buildup.

Drying:

- Squeeze excess water from your dreads with a microfiber towel.
- Allow hair to air dry fully, or use a hooded dryer on a low setting. Avoid sleeping with wet dreads to prevent odor and mildew.

Products & Styling:

- Avoid heavy oils, waxes, or creams that can cause buildup.
- Use lightweight leave-in sprays or recommended products only.
- Avoid excessive pulling, tight ponytails, or styles that place tension on the scalp.

Sleeping:

· Cover dreads with a silk or satin scarf or use a silk pillowcase to reduce friction and prevent frizz.

Swimming:

- Wear a swim cap when swimming to minimize chlorine/salt exposure.
- · Rinse dreads thoroughly after swimming.

Itching & Scalp Care:

- Use a light, residue-free scalp spray if needed.
- Do not scratch or pick at the scalp; consult your stylist if you experience persistent irritation.
- Take Benadryl

WHEN TO WASH YOUR EXTENSIONS:

- 1. Once a week, every other day or every 2 weeks, its completely up to you and what works for you.
- 2. A great way to do hair is to pick a day, wash your hair and thoroughly dry it, then flat iron or curl it.
- 3. It is important to flat iron your hair at least twice a month, doing a good flat iron job on your hair so you can brush through to remove all knots and/or dreads. This will help with the longevity of your extensions. Also, pulling the extensions apart if you find them connecting to the extensions next to them, sometimes the hairs will latch together. If you get dreads or hair extensions that stick together do not stress, it is normal.
 - **Every 6 weeks- you can get a treatment on your extensions and flat iron service before you need to have them removed or replaced. This is a \$150 service but our Jr. Stylist offers it at a discounted rate of just \$75!

 This service can be so worth it and it gives you additional months!**
