HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR EXTENSIONS:

Daily Care:

- Always handle your Halo extension with clean, dry hands.
- Store your Halo in a dry place—preferably in its original box or a silk/satin bag to prevent tangling.
- Gently brush your Halo before and after each use with a soft-bristle, starting from the ends and working upward.

Washing:

- Wash your Halo only when necessary (every 5-10 wears or when product buildup is noticeable).
- Use sulfate-free, extension-safe shampoo and conditioner (we recommend Davines).
- Detangle before washing. Gently soak in lukewarm water, apply shampoo in a downward motion, rinse, and repeat with conditioner.
- **Do not rub, twist, or wring the hair.**
- After rinsing, gently blot excess water with a towel. Lay flat to air dry on a clean towel.

Styling:

- Use heat tools sparingly and always apply a heat protectant.
- Avoid high heat settings to maintain the integrity of the hair.
- Do not color, bleach, or chemically treat your Halo extension at home—consult your stylist for any modifications.

Wearing:

- Ensure your natural hair is dry and tangle-free before applying your Halo.
- Remove your Halo extension before sleeping, swimming, or exercising.
- Avoid exposing your Halo to saltwater, chlorine, or excessive sunlight.

Product Use:

- Use lightweight, extension-friendly styling products only.
- Avoid oils, heavy serums, or products containing alcohol, as these can cause buildup or dryness.
